From Violence to Peace: Experience the peaceful and prosperous results of a region that used to be destitute and violent. Due to

water stress and scarcity people had no way to provide for their families. Some migrated, others resorted to violence to survive. Years later these same people turned over their arms and asked for forgiveness, as they were now peaceful farmers.
